Class 6.2, infectious substances, comprises of those substances known or reasonably expected to contain pathogens which can cause infectious disease in humans or animals. Substances of Class 6.2 are subdivided as follows:</p> <p>11 - UN 2814 INFECTIOUS SUBSTANCE, AFFECTING HUMANS (Category A)</p> <p>12 - UN 2900 INFECTIOUS SUBSTANCE, AFFECTING ANIMALS only</p> <p>13 - UN 3291 CLINICAL WASTE (Category B).</p> <p>14 - UN 3373 BIOLOGICAL SUBSTANCES</p>	Stericycle
